Littleton Youth Ballet is a performing ballet company comprised of 86 young dancers between the ages of 8 to 18. Our mission is to maintain a first-rate non-profit youth company of dancers, enriching their lives and those of their families, schools, communities, and beyond. We also aim to provide a caring and respectful environment that offers each dancer quality performance experience to enable them to reach their fullest potential, not only as dancers, but in all areas of life. We strive to encourage and promote dance with dynamic, full-length productions and diverse outreach programs throughout the Denver area.

All of our dancers are students at Littleton Ballet Academy. Many of our upper-level students have won awards and scholarships in ballet competitions and have been accepted and/or received scholarships and stipends to nationally recognized ballet schools across the nation.

### **About Littleton Ballet Academy**

Littleton Ballet Academy is a pre-professional ballet school in Littleton. Run by co-directors, Alison and Bobbie Jaramillo, the school focuses on ballet while also offering training in jazz, tap, contemporary, musical theatre, conditioning, and Pilates Reformer to create strong and versatile dancers. In 2020, LBA was awarded Outstanding School by Youth American Grand Prix and dancers have been invited to YAGP Finals for the last four years. Dancers have also done well at the Denver Ballet Guild Young Dancer's Competition (winning the David Parvin Award twice) and StarQuest (in 2020 all seven ensembles placed including a 1<sup>st</sup> place finish). Dancers have also been accepted and/or received scholarships and stipends to nationally recognized ballet schools across the nation.

Littleton Ballet Academy is a performance-based school meaning that committed dancers have lots of opportunities to participate in Littleton Youth Ballet productions, outreaches, benefits, and possibly some ballet competitions. Dancers in Ballet 3 and higher have the chance to perform four times a year on a real stage and learn to develop stage awareness and presence, experience how a ballet is created, and as they grow, even the chance to create a leading or supporting role in a ballet.

Our environment is strict but caring, encouraging students to work at their fullest potential. We have a wonderful family feel in our studio, with supportive parents, and the younger students being able to look up to the older students. Our faculty and staff become involved in the development of all our students. Our goal is to produce dancers who are wonderful people that will succeed in anything they wish to do whether it's a career in ballet or something else.

The year is 1902 in Littleton, Colorado and the Stahlbaum Family is throwing a Christmas party, for their friends and their children, Clara and Fritz. The party grows quite festive until suddenly Clara's godfather Drosselmeyer arrives. The children are initially afraid but soon they warm to him as they become amazed at his extraordinary behavior. He first brings in pint-sized Marionette Dolls followed by three magical life size dolls: Columbine, Harlequin, and a Soldier Doll. They are the delight of the party, each taking a turn to dance. The children begin to open gifts when Drosselmeyer presents Fritz with a gift. He then gives Clara a wooden nutcracker in the form of a toy soldier. She is immediately enraptured by it, but Fritz becomes jealous and grabs the nutcracker away from Clara and breaks it. Clara is heartbroken looking on as Drosselmeyer quickly repairs the nutcracker with his handkerchief. As the evening grows late, the guests depart and the Stahlbaum family retires for the evening. Clara, worried about her beloved nutcracker, sneaks back to the tree to check on him but notices that strange things are happening. She is surrounded by child-sized mice and the Christmas tree begins to grow! Then the nutcracker begins to grow as well as he leads his army of toy soldiers into battle with giant rats lead by the Mouse King. The soldiers fight valiantly but the Mouse King corners the Nutcracker and battles him one-on-one. As all hope seems lost, Clara makes a final daring charge hitting the Mouse King with her slipper. The Mouse King is distracted, and the Nutcracker deals his final blow. The Mouse King drops to the floor and the rats sadly carry off their leader's lifeless body. However, the spell is broken, and the Nutcracker turns into a handsome Prince! He takes Clara on a journey to the Land of Snow, an enchanted forest wonderland where they are welcomed by the Snow Queen and King and dancing frost and snowflakes.

The Prince escorts Clara on a beautiful sleigh to the Land of Sweets where they are greeted by tiny angels, candy canes, cooks, and jesters who then lead them to the beautiful Sugar Plum Fairy. The Prince tells everyone about the daring battle with the army of mice and she rewards them with a celebration of dances. Clara enjoys fiery Spanish dancers, the sensuous Arabian pas de deux, and the amusing Chinese dancers. They are followed by the brilliant Russian dancers and the delicate Mirlitons and their lambs. Mother Ginger and her children are sent to entertain Clara. Beautiful flowers dance a vibrant waltz led by the Dew Drop Fairy and are followed by the beautiful Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier dancing a pas de deux. As the inhabitants of the Land of the Sweets bid her farewell Clara awakens from her dream and finds herself by her Christmas tree with her beloved Nutcracker. Was it all a dream or a Christmas fantasy come true?


