Dress Code

Ballet 1 (approx. ages 6 to 12)

- Light blue leotard (any style, NO skirts)
- Light pink footed tights
- Pink ballet shoes with elastic strap
- Acceptable brands are Theatricals, Capezio, Mirella, Natalie, Bloch, Body Wrappers, and Motionwear
- Hair should be in a ballet bun. If it is too short for a ponytail, please wear a headband.

Other Information

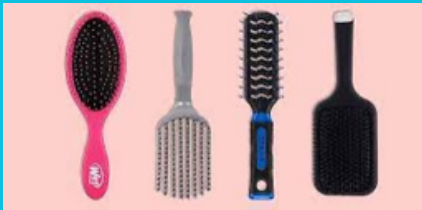
- All students need a ballet bag to keep shoes in.
- Dancers should appear neat at all times.
- The student's name should be on ALL dancewear, especially shoes.
- Drawstrings need to be tucked into shoes.
- Students should always wear street clothing over their ballet attire when coming to and from their classes.
- Dance shoes must never be worn outdoors as this tracks dirt into the studio and is detrimental to the marley floors.
- No jewelry is allowed except small earrings and rings.
- Girls may wear a colored leotard and boys may wear a colored shirt on their birthday or the class closest to it.



How to Do Your Hair in A Ballet Bun

You will need the following:

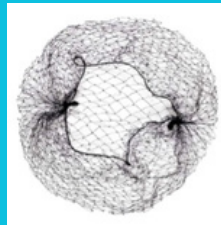
A hair tie or hair elastic (make sure it's thick enough if your child has a lot of hair)



A brush



Bun cover OR



Hair net the color of hair



Bobby pins

Step 1: Use the brush to pull hair into a neat ponytail in the middle of your child's head.

Step 2: Divide the hair into two parts and coil one around the ponytail. Use a couple of bobby pins to pin the hair.

Step 3: Coil the rest of the hair and you can use a few more bobby pins to secure the hair.

Step 4: Use a hair net or bun cover on the bun and pin this in using 4 or 5 bobby pins. Voila!

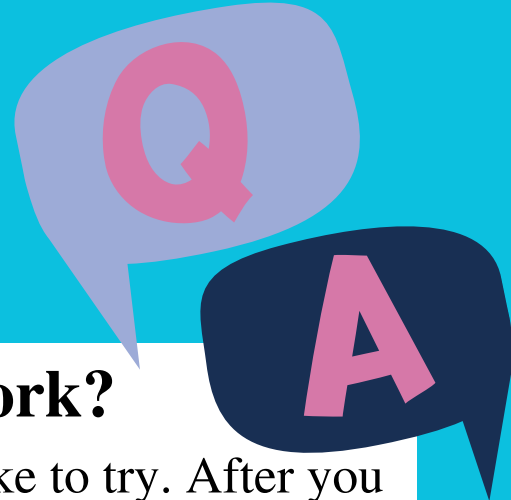
Absences

Frequently Asked Questions



How does registration work?

Please register online for the class you would like to try. After you try a class we will hold a spot for 24 hours. How does tuition work?

Tuition is automatically charged on the first of the month to the credit or debit card on file.

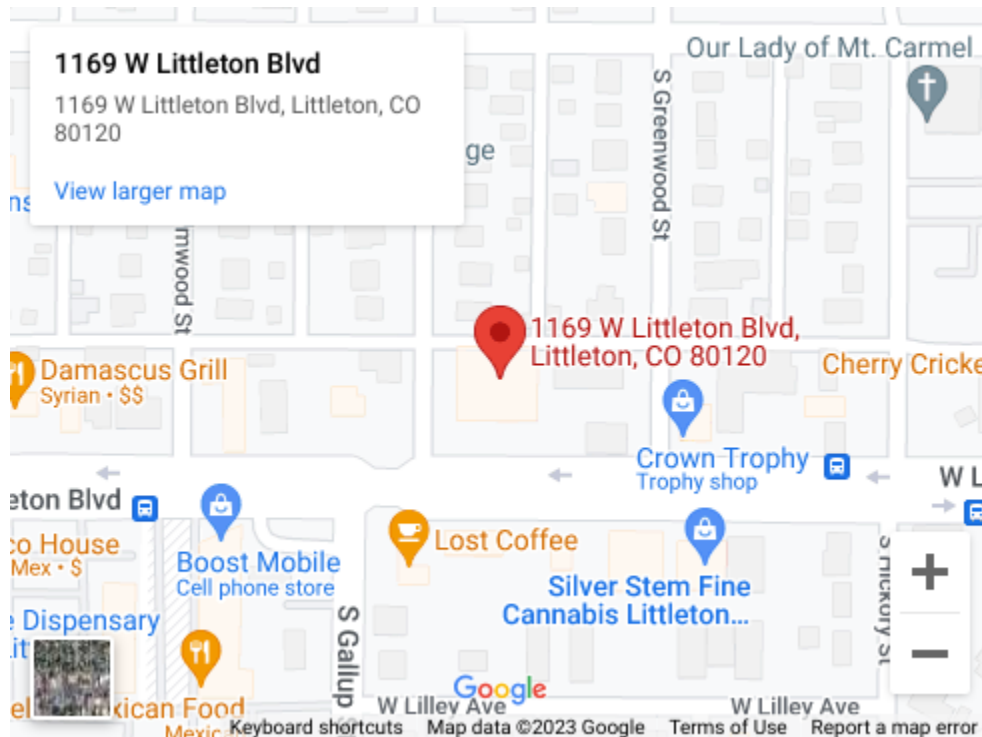
It said my payment was posted. Does that mean my card was charged?

When joining LBA, all new students during the Academic Year are committed to three months of classes (except in the Adult Division).
